

## Equine Activity Release and Hold Harmless

1) I, as participant or parent of participant, acknowledge that equine activities are athletic activities that pose potentially serious risk of injuries or death to participants in equine activities. I acknowledge that there are certain intrinsic dangers or conditions that are an integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to; (I) the propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons, (II) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to things such as sounds, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals, (III) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions, (IV) collisions with other animals or objects; and (V) the potential of a participant acting in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within participant's ability (collectively, "Intrinsic Dangers of Equine Activities"). I understand that participants in equine activities may be injured or killed as a result of their own negligence, the negligence of others or through no fault of participants or anyone else.

2) I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, boarding, feeding said horse; including, but not limited to any interaction with other horses. Understanding those risks I hereby release Kathy Tomkins of Mobile Home Parts Center LLC, Roy Kareus and Helen (Shelle) deVergie of Par & Memaw, LLC, Billy Walker of Renegade Grille LLC, Heather Thom of True Riding Free LLC, George Brauneis of Eagle and Wild Horse Ranch, Shane & Melodie Marye of Creations by Ja-Mel, Michael Headlee of The Rockin M/D Ranch, Grand Mesa Back Country Horsemen and Grand Valley Horse Rescue, their officers, directors, employees, and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with these entities from any liability whatsoever, in the event of injury or damage of any nature (or perhaps even death) to me or anyone else caused by or incidental to my electing to mount and ride a horse owned by myself or someone else.

3) I further voluntarily agree to warrant Release and Hold Harmless these equine professionals from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional's negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to injuries, death or property damage from mounting, riding, dismounting, walking, grooming, feeding, use of horse barn, paddock, or horse arenas, in any

capacity, falling off a horse whether bucking, flipping, spooking, or my failure to under any professional's directions relating to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or the horse I have been assigned to or any horse on the premises.

4) I further understand that everyone under the age of 18 participating in equine activities are required to wear a helmet and boots.
